IOWA BANKERS' ASSOCIATION BACK OF MOVEMENT TO PROMOTE AGRICULTURE.

State College at Ames Co-operating in Movement to Advance Farm Educational Work—Films to Be Shown in Various Cities—Methods of Growing Wheat to Be Depicted.

Ames, June 15.—The Iowa Bankers' association is co-operating in a movement by which it is hoped to have shown in every town in Iowa moving pictures of proper methods of doing farm work.

The action of the bankers' association is in line with its efforts of this year to make the county corn growing contest a success.

Iowa State College also is co-operating in this farm movie scheme, and some of the pictures will be taken under its supervision.

It is proposed by the company to produce fifty or sixty different films, each dealing with a different subject.

Wheat Growing Methods. One of the films will show the proper methods of growing wheat, from the sowing to the threshing.
