DANIEL BOONE TRAIL. Good Roads Advocates Form Organization to Construct New Highway—Tentative Route From Des Moines to Elmore, Minn.

Fort Dodge, Dec. 9.—The Daniel Boone trail, for the present from Des Moines thru Fort Dodge to Elmore, Minn., was born Wednesday at a meeting of Boone and Fort Dodge good roads enthusiasts.

J. B. Surprising was elected temporary president until the meeting here Dec. 21 to form a permanent organization.

Floyd Douglas of this city was elected corresponding secretary and S. L. Moore of Boone was elected temporary treasurer.
