### WAR RUMORS AFFECT MARKET FOR WHEAT

#### REPORTED SEIZURE OF GERMAN SHIPS IN BRAZIL CAUSES DECLINE.

#### ENLARGED SHIPMENTS ALSO HANDICAP BULLS

Corn Gives Way Under Heavy Selling. Pressure Resulting From Sympathy With Decline in Wheat—Oats Reflect Course of Other Cereals But Buying Is Active on the Break.

Chicago, March 17.—Assertions that forty-four German ships had been seized by the Brazilian government caused a decided setback today in the price of wheat. Confirmation was lacking and it was thought likely that the report was confused. Enlarged shipments from Australia and Argentina acted as a further handicap on the bulls. Opening prices, which ranged from 1/4 to 1 1/4 cents lower, with May at \$1.08 1/4, and July at \$1.08 1/4, were followed by a slight rally but then a material further decline.

The close was heavy: 2 1/4 to 3 1/4, and 3 1/4 cents net lower with May at \$1.08 1/4 and July at \$1.08 1/4 to \$1.08 1/4.

Corn gave way under heavy selling. The pressure resulted from sympathy with the weakness of wheat. After opening a shade to 1/4 lower, the market reacted a little, but later suffered a substantial decline.

[From Mason Bros. wire, Mason: Temple, Mo., March 17.—Wheat: The recent steady advance in wheat eliminated a large portion of the short interest and the market this morning was in position to respond rapidly to bearish news from abroad. The result was a sharp break in price with only moderate support from resting orders and a considerable volume of stop loss selling. Recoveries due to over enthusiasm on part of locals who were for the most part bearish. Crop reports have been given less attention and fewer complaints of damage were received. Liverpool gave no definite reason for weakness in their market but hinted that important developments were expected in the political situation.

Corn—Corn was affected by wheat and by the same news that depressed the wheat market. A considerable volume of commission house selling was accompanied by heavy pressure from local traders. Elevator interests bought May and held July at 1 cent premium for the latter.

Oats—Oats did not fully follow the weakness in other grains. Cash houses were moderate buyers and local traders bought against sales of corn. Unlike corn, oats are moving out in considerable volume both from primary markets and from the seaboard.

### LEFT-OVER SUPPLY DEPRESSES HOGS

#### TEN THOUSAND HEAD LEFT UN-SOLD FROM THURSDAY PLACED ON SALE.

#### PRICES RECEDE 10 CENTS ON WEAKENED MARKET

#### Cattle Prices Upheld Only Because Supplies Are Scanty—Offerings of Sheep and Lambs Show Quality Below Usual Standard—Review of Market Conditions.

Chicago, March 17.—Hogs weakened in price today owing to the fact that 10,000 had been left over unsold last night.

Eleven markets received 97,500 hogs Thursday, or 18,989 more than last Thursday, 14,900 more than a year ago and 43,100 more than two years ago. Total thus far this week 462,000, or 64,000 more than same period last week, 12,900 more than like time last year, and 113,000 more than corresponding four days two years ago. Total for 1915 to date 8,257,000, or 1,313,000 more than same period 1915 and 2,695,000 more than corresponding time 1914.

Cattle.

Cattle values were only upheld by scantiness of the supply.

The week started off with moderate receipts, but the midweek run, which was larger than expected, is bringing the week's total right up to last week. Thursday's run at 3,500 head was more than the trade expected and compared with 4,435 a week ago, 4,323 a year ago and 3,184 for same day two years ago.

Severe snow and sleet storms throughout the eastern states, especially in the northern sections, kept much stock from being sent from here Wednesday. After it was bought it had to be held because railroads were unable to deliver it to the various points in the east. The storm which covered a wide area from Ohio to New York, played havoc with the railroads and caused the holding over here of stock intended for shipment. Reports Thursday said that the roads are being cleared and no further hindrance of handling stock will result.

During the first four days of the week there have been about 38,000 cattle received at Chicago, against 40,228 for same days last week, 30,550 a year ago and 35,775 for corresponding period two years ago.

At the seven principal western markets Thursday there were about 24,400 cattle received, against 17,500 a week ago, 14,000 a year ago and 9,900 for corresponding period two years ago.

Western markets have increased over last week's total. Packers have been able to get good supplies at the various points, which caused them to go slow here on the Wednesday market.

#### NOW CONVINCED IOWAN IS FACTOR IN RACE

#### Old Guard Ready to Concede That Weeks, Fairbanks and Others Are Impossibilities—Discussion Narrowing to Three Men, Cummins, Roosevelt and Hughes—Rawson Helpful.

[Special Correspondence.]

Washington, March 17.—Since the establishment of Cummins headquarters here, with State Chairman Rawson in charge, there has been a manifest disposition in eastern political circles to give increased attention to the possibilities of the nomination of Senator Cummins for president.

For months many of the eastern politicians and eastern newspapers refused to take seriously the idea that a man from west of the Mississippi could be nominated. That frame of mind no longer obtains. In all the discussions of the presidential situation, Senator Cummins is today reckoned as a real factor.

On the other hand, there is more and more evidence that the candidacies of Weeks, McCall, Root, Fairbanks, Burton and others of the old guard are regarded as foredoomed to failure.

It is true that among that class of politicians who know nothing of the temper of the nation west of the Alleghenies mountains there is still serious talk of the prospects of some of these candidates. But among men who whatever their personal views, have a broad understanding of political conditions, there are just three presidential possibilities on the republican side who are talked of as actual probabilities. Senator Cummins is one of these three. Roosevelt and Hughes are the others.

As a matter of fact, this has been the case for some weeks. But as time passes and the period to elapse before the convention grows shorter, the prominence of these three men is emphasized.

Rawson is Hopeful.

State Chairman Rawson will be in Washington in active work at headquarters for several weeks. In the meantime, he will visit some of the surrounding states. He has substantial hope for delegates in a number of the eastern and southern states. In a number of instances, Senator Cummins will be second choice and this may in the long run prove of decisive value in the convention.

At one time, it was expected Senator Cummins would go into Pennsylvania, his native state. This plan has been given up because of the fact Senator Cummins does not care to fight Governor Brumbaugh, who has become a candidate. The disclosure that Cummins might enter Pennsylvania was accompanied by amusing developments. It caused Senators Penrose and Penrose and his leaders was the more marked because they realized a number of the republicans were friendly to the Iowa senator.
