

GOOD'S AMENDMENT TO HAY ARMY BILL

IOWA CONGRESSMAN SUCCEEDS IN HAVING IMPORTANT PROVISION ADOPTED.

INDUSTRIAL CONCERNS TO BE MOBILIZED

All Plants Making Munitions or Capable of Manufacturing Them to Be Made of Record and Available Should War Impend—Government Would Take Control and Pay Owners.

[Special Correspondence.] Washington, March 28.—One of the most important provisions in the army bill as passed by the house was put in at the instance of Representative Good. Virtually, it makes it possible for the government in time of war to draw to its support...

Under amendments presented by Mr. Good and adopted, the government will list all arms and munitions plants and

all plants which can readily be transformed into plants for the manufacture of arms, munitions or any sort of war material. Plans for transformation will be perfected by the secretary of war.

the efforts of Mr. Good, apart from the reference to the listing of establishments, is: "Any individual firm, association, company, corporation or organized manufacturing industry owning or operating any plant equipped for the manufacture of arms or ammunition, or parts of arms or ammunition, or any necessary supplies or equipment for the army, and any individual, firm, association, company, corporation, or organized manufacturing industry owning or operating any manufacturing plant which in the opinion of the secretary of war is capable of being readily transformed into a plant for the manufacture of arms or ammunition, or other parts thereof, or other necessary supplies or equipment, who refuses to give the United States such preference in the matter of the execution of orders, or who refuses to manufacture the kind, quantity, or quality of arms or ammunition, or the parts thereof, or any necessary supplies or equipment as ordered by the secretary of war, or who refuses to furnish such arms, ammunition, or other supplies or equipment, at a reasonable price, as determined by the secretary of war, then and in either such case, the president, thru the head of the department of the government, in addition to the present authorized methods of purchase or procurement herein provided for, is authorized to take immediate possession of any such plant or plants, and thru the ordnance department of the United States army, to manufacture therein in the time of war, or when war is imminent, such product or material as may be required, and any individual, firm, company, association or corporation, or organized manufacturing industry."
