Receiving a message from her son Howard, at Cherokee, repeating a message received by him from Williams Bridge, N. Y., Mrs. Cora Berkstresser, of Mount Carroll, Ill., who is in the city visiting her brother, Superintendent A. Palmer, of the public schools, was in a quandary to know how to get information concerning her son William, who the message stated, was to undergo an operation Saturday at Williams Bridge.

As Mrs. Berkstresser recently had received a letter from her son William saying that he was in the best of health, the mother was greatly worried, fearing that he had met with some sort of an accident. As her son had been stationed at Camp Merritt, N. J., Mrs. Berkstresser was at a loss to know why he should be at Williams Bridge. The message as forwarded her contained only the signature of her son Howard, and not that of the person who filed the original telegram.

Knowing that the Red Cross was anxious and willing to get relatives of soldiers seeking information, Mr. Palmer Saturday morning filed a telegram addressed to Red Cross headquarters, Williams Bridge, N. Y., asking the nature of the illness and the condition of the patient. By the middle of the afternoon the reply came that Berkstresser's operation was for hernia and his condition was good.

Berkstresser is in the motor trucks service, and his ailment, no doubt, has been due to heavy lifting. His mother, who has been spending the winter in Colorado, will leave shortly for Mount Carroll.

SEARCH FOR MAN; FIND HIM SUICIDE

WILLIAM WINTERMEYER, BAXTER, ENDS LIFE BY HANGING WHILE OFFICER SEEKS HIM,

ALLEGED HE THREATENED RHODES FARMER WITH GUN

Constable From Rhodes Held Warrant, and in Making Search Wintermeyer's Dead Body is Found Hanging in Buggy Shed on Father's Farm—Coroner's Jury Says Suicide.

While Constable Williams, of Rhodes, Sunday was seeking William Wintermeyer, aged 28, of Baxter, with a warrant charging threatening to commit a public offense, the search came to an unexpected end at 5 o'clock Sunday evening, when Wintermeyer's dead body was found in a buggy shed on his father's farm, near Baxter. Wintermeyer had hanged himself.

The information, from the justice court of H. M. Weeks, of Rhodes, was filed Sunday morning by Walter Greer, a farmer living in the southern part of Eden township. Following some disagreement it was claimed that Wintermeyer had threatened Greer with a shotgun.

Coroner's Jury Says Suicide. The inquest over Wintermeyer's body was held Sunday night at the Wintermeyer farm by the coroner of Jasper county. The jury returned a verdict of self destruction, it was said at Rhodes.

HOMER VEATCH NOT DEAD.

Erroneous Report From Cedar Falls Relative to Farmer Liscumb's Boy.

The Times-Republican printed a few days ago from Cedar Falls a story to the effect that Homer Veatch, son of Mr. and Mrs. William L. Veatch, of Cedar Falls, and formerly living on a farm southeast of Liscumb, was dead at Fort Leavenworth, Kan., where he was in the army.

The error doubtless originated at Cedar Falls thru the fact that William L. Veatch received a death message, from Amelia, Va., telling of the death of Frank Veatch, the 6-year-old son of Emory C. Veatch, the latter a brother of W. L. Veatch. Evidently some one, knowing that Mr. Veatch had received a letter telling of a death in the family, jumped at the conclusion that Mr. Veatch's son Homer was dead and so circulated the report, which was printed in Cedar Falls and Waterloo newspapers.



BOND DRIVE ON; LEGRAND IS OVER

TOWNSHIP REPORTS \$50,000 SUBSCRIPTION ON ALLOTMENT OF \$48,000; STILL WORKING.

LOGAN REPORTS UNOFFICIALLY ALLOTMENT OVERSCRIBED

Farmers and Townsman Buy at Gatherings at Melbourne and Vanclève—Washington Township Sells Three-Fourths of Its Quota—Campaign in City Opens Tuesday—Committees to Be at Club.

Altho the third liberty loan campaign was not supposed to open in the county until Sunday, in one township at least it got under way Saturday. Two townships, LeGrand and Logan, were reported early today to have already gone over the top in their campaigns. LeGrand oversubscribed its allotment Sunday, and was the first to report, but Logan is reported unofficially to have also oversubscribed at Melbourne and Vanclève Saturday. Washington township sold most of its allotment Sunday at the county farm.

In the city the campaign opens Tuesday. Notices were received in the morning mail by those who were appraised that they were expected to subscribe for at least the amount of their appraisement at the Marshalltown Club Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday. Committees from each ward will be on duty all of each of the four days to take the subscriptions. Those who fail to answer the summons will be called on.

LeGrand Reports First. LeGrand township, regardless of the fear of religious objections, was the first to report to report its bond sales over the top. On an allotment of \$48,000, \$50,000 worth of bonds were sold Sunday and the committees are still working.

Logan township is reported unofficially to have oversubscribed its allotment at Van Clève and Melbourne Saturday where the farmers and townsman gathered as an election day, signed orders for their bonds and left their checks for the amounts appraised by the township committee.

At the county farm in Washington township more than half the residents of that township called Sunday and subscribed for \$20,000 worth of bonds on an allotment of \$42,000 for the township. Every person ordered not less than the committee's appraisal and some bought more.
