HERCULANEUM

WILL BE EXCAVATED AND ALL ITS SECRETS REVEALED.

Consent of King of Italy Secured and Government Will Be Approached.

Rome, Nov. 13.—Charles Waldstein, professor of fine arts in Kings College, Oxford, England, will arrive here shortly and perfect an agreement with the Italian government concerning the carrying out of his project for the excavation of the ancient city of Herculaneum. The professor's plans to this end have been accepted by the Italian government on the condition that the participation of foreign countries in the work be only under the form of private contributions, and that there be no foreign official interference.

Professor Waldstein has procured the active co-operation of King Victor Emmanuel, as president of his organization, as well as that of Emperor William, King Edward and President Roosevelt. The excavation of Herculaneum will be a gigantic enterprise. The work of digging up the ancient city was begun by King Charles III. in 1738, and it was continued under the direction of the Italian government in 1866. This excavation always has been attended with the greatest difficulty, as over the ruins of the ancient city there stands today the town of Resina, with 20,000 inhabitants. The location of Resina often has made it necessary to abandon the research.

Inmate Of Poor House, Elected To Office, Died.

Lyon County Citizens Are Stirred Up Over Series of Incendiary Fires.

LITTLE GIRL KILLED SUNDAY.

Fulton, Ky., Nov. 13.—After defeating his opponent, who was possessed of wealth, for the position of Dyer county register, John H. Ripley, inmate of the poor house at the time he made the spectacular race, is dead. He succumbed at Newbern. Mr. Ripley was a cripple. He beat Joe J. Hood, who had held the office for twelve years. The deceased's mother is an invalid, and also occupant of the poor house, and it was the wish of the people who elected him at a ratio of 3 to 1 that mother and son be restored to the position occupied before adversity overtook them.

Child Killed by Lumber.

Owensboro, Ky., Nov. 13.—A falling stack of lumber resulted in the death of one child Sunday afternoon and the injury of two others. The dead child is Maggie Able and the two injured ones are her sisters. The girl who was killed was ten years old and the two injured children are eight and six. All of the children are the daughters of a widow, Mrs. Rie Able, who resides on Hamilton avenue. The accident occurred Sunday afternoon at 4 o'clock in the yards of the I. C. railroad. The three little tots were playing hide and seek around the lumber stack when it fell on them.

Another Stock Barn Burned.

Eddyville, Nov. 13.—R. A. Sexton, a well-to-do farmer in the northern part of the county, suffered a loss of \$1,500 by the burning of his stock farm Friday night. Besides the barn, two mules, one horse, farming implements and a large lot of corn and hay were lost.
