The Commercial-Appeal, answering many letters as to the Confederate Reunion says:

Any veteran not feeling able to pay for his board and lodging can get the same free of charge by applying to J. S. Davant, chairman of the information committee. If he does not care to make the application in person the veteran can make the same through the commander of his camp.

Any veteran desiring to pay for his board and lodging can secure meals and sleeping accommodation at prices ranging from a dollar a day up.

Some captious criticism has been made as to extortion. There will be more free entertainment and a greater variety offered by Memphis than was offered by any other reunion city.

Entrance to the court of honor will be free to the veterans and their wives. The fireworks display will be free to veterans and their wives.

The flower parade will be free to veterans and their wives.

The sponsors' ball will be free to veterans and their wives.

An elaborate athletic carnival at the Auditorium will be free to veterans and their wives.

The Southern Cross drill will be free to veterans and their wives.
