Hot Sand as a Bedfellow.

The comfort which a hot water bag or even a hot brick may afford a person on retiring, chilled, is very great, and beyond this, the use of some such warmth-producing appliances is useful as a health preservative and restorative. But one of the most convenient articles to be used as a bed warmer and in a sick room is a sand bag. Get some, clean, fine sand, dry it thoroughly in a kettle on the stove, make a bag about 8 in. square of flannel, fill it with dry sand sew the opening carefully together, and cover the bag with a cotton or linen cloth. This will prevent the sand from sifting out and will also enable you to heat the bag quickly by placing it in the oven, or on top of the stove. After once using this you will never again attempt to warm the feet or hands of a sick person with a bottle of hot water or a brick. The sand holds the heat a long time, and the bag can be tucked up to the back without hurting the invalid. It is a good plan to make two or three of the bags and keep them ready for use.
