



Of the 14 defendants indicted by the grand jury, but 11 have appeared for trial. Three have not been apprehended. The defendants include Messrs. Alderson and Ray, president and treasurer of the company; Robert Sidebotham and J. G. G. Wilmot, fiscal agents and promoters; D. G. Bertoglio, a Meaderville merchant and one of the directors; J. W. Spear of Great Falls, Miss M. A. Cort, an office employe of the company; C. A. Rainwater, C. W. Tobin and E. C. Willis.

Smith and Park Smith of Helena, John G. Brown and C. A. Spaulding of Helena, former Governor Hawley of Idaho and F. A. McDonough of Great Falls. GREAT EXPLOSION OF 22 YEARS AGO

Survivors Meet in Butte—Officer Steinborn Recalls His Experience.

Twenty-two years ago today Patrolman John H. Steinborn noticed a fire on the Northern Pacific tracks. He turned in the alarm and one hour later 50 Butte people were being rushed to the morgues in the city, while 250 were being cared for in local hospitals. Today is the twenty-second anniversary of the great explosion.

quiet dinner will be held at the home of one of the men and the events of the terrific explosion will be recalled. "The fire started about 10 o'clock in the evening, 22 years ago today," said Officer Steinborn. "I happened to be on that beat and when I noticed the flames I sent in a call for the department. The firemen responded immediately and rushed in to extinguish the flames. Then came the first explosion, which was a small one compared to the second blast. The first department was wiped out with the exception of four men. Three of these are still living. More than 50 people were killed and 250 were injured. I was badly hurt and it was several months before I was able to leave the hospital. "It has been our custom to meet every year in a little dinner. Our numbers are growing smaller each year. Last year there were four and this year but three."
