Cabinet Considering Question Presented by Presence of Many Aliens.

The Post's Washington Bureau. Washington, D. C., Feb. 19.—The cabinet is giving careful consideration to the problem presented by the presence in this country of thousands of men of German birth, who have not become American citizens.

In case of war, it is pointed out, there would be no question as to the right of the United States to intern them in detention camps, but plainly the government would not wish to take this step unless forced to do it.

The most desirable solution of the problem is through the naturalization of these aliens. That this fact is recognized is shown by the information coming to the bureau of naturalization that naturalization officers in every section of the country have been busy during the last few days.

Helena, Feb. 19.—Not more than one-half of the 600-odd bills introduced in the house and senate of the Fifteenth assembly have been disposed of. When the house adjourned Saturday evening it had nearly 160 bills still to consider and fully as many more senate bills.

Most of the members of the house have abandoned the idea of considering all the bills remaining, and Saturday there was considerable talk of a sifting committee which would separate the chaff from the wheat and dictate the order in which bills should be considered.

Why all this piling up of business at the end of the session? Well, one observer of the house declares that body actually worked not to exceed 16 hours the first month. It put in more time, but not in work that counted.
