BUTTE BOY LEAVES TO WORK IN PERU

Mahlon Miller Starts Saturday Night to Join the Cerro de Pasco Company.

Miller of 632 West Quartz street, employed in the engineering department of the Anaconda Copper Mining company, leaves tomorrow night for Peru, where he has been offered a very flattering contract from the Cerro de Pasco Mining company. Mr. Miller is a graduate of the mining engineering department of the University of Utah. In addition to his experience in the Butte mines, he has had experience in mines in Park City and Bingham, Utah, although just a young man.

He goes direct to New York, where he reports to the New York office of the company, which is composed of English and New York capitalists. He is well known here and his many friends wish him every success in his new field and, in fact, are assured that the same measure of success will follow him in Peru as in Butte.

MASHER IS FINED; INSULTED COUPLE

Tim Harrington, for 17 Years a Resident of Butte, Forgets Himself.

Tim Harrington, for 17 years a resident of Butte and about 32 years old, with his hair turning gray, was fined \$10 in the police court this morning on charges of creating a disturbance by insulting young women on the streets. Harrington denied that he had willfully insulted any woman, although his testimony was flatly contradicted by Officer Brady and another witness, both of whom saw him deliberately approach one young girl, and by the witness who saw him bother another woman a few minutes before the officer was called.

Harrington said that he was drunk, but the witnesses said he was not so drunk that he approached women who had escorts. He was first seen to stop a woman at the corner of Arizona and Aluminum streets. He approached this woman, tapped her on the shoulder and asked her to come with him. She paid no attention, but told the officer that she did not know Harrington. He grabbed a second woman by the arm and she jerked away from him and told him to mind his own business, the witness said.

The first girl he met was about 14 or 15 years old. "You may not be Jack the Huggler, but the city of Butte is dangerous enough without oldtimers here like you insulting young women on the streets. The girls who must be out alone have a right to be protected and this court will do all it can for them," Judge Whitty said before passing the sentence.
