COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 1414

A resolution declaring the intention of the city council of the city of Butte to create Special Improvement District No. 228, describing its boundaries, stating the general character of improvements which are to be made, estimating the approximate cost thereof and extending the payments of assessments over a period of five years.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Butte:

Section 1. That the city council of the city of Butte does hereby declare its intention to create a special improvement district within the limits of the city of Butte, to be designated Special Improvement District No. 228.

Section 2. The boundaries of said district are described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point which is the northeast corner of lot No. 25, block 5E, Montrose addition; thence easterly along the east line of lot No. 26, block 5E, Montrose addition, extended a distance of 260 feet to the southeast corner of lot No. 10, block No. 7, MacGinnis Heights addition; thence westerly along the north line of Porphyry alley a distance of 300 feet to the southwest corner of lot No. 1, block No. 3, MacGinnis Heights addition; thence southerly 16 feet to the northeast corner of lot No. 22, block No. 3, MacGinnis Heights addition; thence easterly along the south line of Porphyry alley a distance of 97.2 feet to the northeast corner of lot No.
