Count Von Reventlow Says Americans Tried to Stir Up Trouble. Amsterdam, Aug. 2.—Count von Reventlow in an article in the Tage Zeitung, referring to Arthur J. Balfour's speech in the house of commons, in which he spoke of the nationalities of Austria-Hungary determining their own course of future developments, tells his readers of widespread machinations of American agents in Austria-Hungary, started by former Ambassador Penfield long prior to the Austro-American breach.

DEMAND FOR SILVER COINS ON INCREASE

Washington, Aug. 2.—Minting silver coins is proceeding every minute at from five to eight times the volume of past years, according to announcement today by Director Baker of the mint, who has just returned to Washington from an inspection tour of the mints in the west.

Amoy, China, Aug. 3.—Today the American dollar here is worth \$1.50 silver in Chinese coin. This represents a drop of three cents since July 1. The normal rate is about \$2.25 silver.

RUMANIA ADDING TO GERMAN FOOD SUPPLY

Zurich, Aug. 3.—The Vienna Neue Freie Presse, in estimating the world's harvest for the year, says that Rumania after supplying the needs of her home population and of the Austrian and German armies was able to send 100 carloads of cereals to Germany and Austria-Hungary.
