Said action is commenced for the purpose of obtaining a divorce and legal separation from you, it being alleged in the complaint: That plaintiff is now and for more than one year next preceding the 14th day of September, 1917, and for more than one year next preceding the filing of this complaint, has been an actual and bona fide resident of the state of Montana. That plaintiff and defendant intermarried at Seattle, Washington, on the 24th day of January, 1916, and ever since that time have been, and now are, husband and wife.
