SUBMARINE LOSSES ARE GROWING FEWER

British, French and Italian Reports Show Great Falling Off.
London, Oct. 4.—Eleven British merchantmen of more than 1,000 tons each and two vessels under 1,000 tons were sunk by mines or submarines last week, according to the British Admiralty statement made public last evening. The shipping summary follows: Arrivals, 2,689; sailings, 2,722. British merchant vessels sunk by

mine or submarine over 1,000 tons, including two previously, 11; under 1,000 tons, 2. Fishing vessels sunk, none. British merchant vessels unsuccessfully attacked, including 7 previously, 16. The foregoing statement again lowers the aggregate of merchantmen sunk during any week since Germany began her intensified submarine campaign. Fifteen vessels were sunk the previous week, which was the low record since February.

FRENCH LOSSES. Paris, Wednesday, Oct. 3.—Weekly report of losses to French shipping by submarines and mines shows that five vessels of more than 1,000 tons each and five of less than that size were destroyed. Four of the smaller ships were lost in the preceding week. Five vessels were attacked unsuccessfully, one of them in the previous week. Six fishing vessels were sunk, two of them in the preceding week.
