



80 PER CENT ADVANCE IN COST OF NECESSITIES

That is Food Situation in England According to Recent Compilation.

Ottawa, Oct. 19.—Beef and mutton in England now exceed their pre-war prices by 18 pence per pound, says the government Labor Gazette. Butter and bacon are now double. Milk is 75 per cent higher than in July, 1914. The cost of all items usually entering into the working class family, including food, rent, clothing, fuel and light, the increase has been nearly 80 per cent, allowing 5 per cent for increased taxation.

COUNT TARNOW IS CHOICE OF THE POLES

Former Austrian Ambassador to U. S. May Become Polish Premier.

Copenhagen, Oct. 19.—A Lemberg dispatch says that Count Tarnowski von Tarnow, former Austro-Hungarian ambassador to the United States, has been proposed by the Poles as their sole candidate for the premiership of the new Polish kingdom, which office is to be filled by the recently appointed Council of Regency. Count Tarnowski's candidacy has been opposed steadily by the Germans.
