Twenty-One Men Lose Their Lives in Accident According to Reports to the Navy

CHAUNCEY TYPE BOAT S GONE DOWN

Daniels Promises Information When Reports Come.

CARRIED 91 OFFICERS AND MEN

Occurred Yesterday Morning—Vessel Was Built in 1902.

Butte, Nov. 20.—Sinking of American destroyer Chauncey in the war zone yesterday morning with a loss of 21 lives was announced today by the navy department. No further details were given in a brief report to the department from Vice Admiral Sims.

Chauncey, a small American destroyer on patrol duty in foreign waters, was sunk in a collision early this morning. First dispatches indicated 21 lives were lost. Further information will be made public as reports are received.

RES AGAINST FIVE MEN ARE WITHDRAWN

PROHIBITION AMENDMENT REJECTED BY VOTE OF 932

ROUNDUP OF GERMANS IN COAST TOWNS

Agents Already at Work in District of Columbia.

SOME ARE LEAVING THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Only Few of Half Million Persons Affected Will Be Arrested.

Washington, Nov. 20.—A roundup of suspected Germans, mainly in seacoast and lake port cities, is in progress today, under authority of President Wilson's proclamation forbidding alien enemies within 100 yards of docks.

The intelligence bureau of the army and navy have charge of making most arrests of Germans not evacuating the new barred zones.

SOME LEAVE CAPITAL

A few Germans left Washington today in compliance with the president's order making a barred zone of the District of Columbia.

TRAIN HITS AUTO BUS LOADED WITH CHILDREN

Two Are Killed and More Than a Dozen Are Injured at Walla Walla.

Walla Walla, Wash., Nov. 20.—Two were killed instantly, one probably fatally injured and twelve more or less seriously hurt when an O. W. R. train, backing over a crossing.

The driver, Philip Ochs, did not see or hear the train and the train crew failed to note the approach of the bus.

TEUTONIC TROOPS ARE TAKEN FROM THE RUSS LINES
