

OTIC WOMEN
HELP RED CROSS

Total of 1,549 Garments Finished by W. R. C. in Past Three Months.

In the past three months the Women's Relief Corps, an auxiliary of the G. A. R., finished 1,549 garments for the Red Cross. It took a total of 852 hours to do this work of mercy.

These figures are shown in the quarterly report of Mrs. Mary J. Wright, president of the W. R. C., the women limited by these patriotic women, who work for the Red Cross every Friday afternoon from 1 to 5 o'clock, consist of pajamas, bed socks, compresses, bed shirts, kits and knitted garments.

Wright's report shows that August the corps and invited help in 246 hours finishing 728 garments. In September they spent for the Red Cross finishing 600. Of these 60 were knitted. In October the women spent 42 hours. During this time finished 113 knitted garments other articles.


