OUTPUT OF COPPER IS BELOW NORMAL

Minor Factors Show Improvement for the Small Consumers.

Anaconda Copper opened today at 58 1/2 and closed at 58 1/2. The gain in United States Steel was even greater.

Regarding the copper market, Dow, Jones & Co. wired to the Heilbronner company today: "Products believe that major aspects of copper situation will not show substantial improvement before February; estimates of the time required for a general easing of conditions have been slightly extended, apparently in view of the fact that mine production for September was smallest of any month of year and output of October, while showing an increase, was still far below normal."

"Meanwhile, however, minor factors have importantly improved the situation for small consumers.
