"Have you anything to say, O'Neill?" asked the judge.

The Sentence.
"The pronouncement of the court," said Judge Dwyer, "is that you and both of you are to be executed in the jail yard of Shreve New county on Monday morning, Jan. 14, 1918, between the hours of 3 a. m. and 11 a. m."

Case of Powell.

A Statement.
"The acreage planted to winter wheat is estimated to be 42,178,000 acres, an increase of 4 per cent over the area planted a year ago. In the campaign to produce a billion bushels of wheat next year to feed our allies an acreage of 42,227,000 of winter wheat was advocated...

Yield Per Acre.
"A quantitative forecast is not usually made from the December condition reports, because great changes for better or worse. But it may be observed that in the past 18 years the yield per acre on the planted acreage was 14.6 bushels; on this basis a condition of 71.2 would forecast a yield of about 12.5 bushels, which on 42,178,000 acres would produce about 548,000,000 bushels...

BRITISH VESSEL UNDER CONVOY IS SENT DOWN

Destroyers Drop Bombs at the Point Where the Sub Went Down.
An Atlantic Fleet Dec. 18.—Sinking of the British steamer City of Naples, 2,724 tons, on Dec. 1 while under convoy of destroyers, by a German submarine was reported on the arrival today of an American steamship. The vessel, which was in ballast and was under charter to a Liverpool line, was just ahead of the American ship when struck by a torpedo. This was at a point five days from Plymouth, England, the master of the American vessel reported. After the City of Naples was struck, destroyers dropped four depth bombs over the spot where the submarine was believed to have been.
