

AID TO MRS. TAFT

MISS ALICE BLECH CHOSEN FOR RESPONSIBLE POSITION.

Will Fulfill the Duties of Social Clerk to the Mistress of the White House—Post Is Most Important.

Washington.—Women and men in the social world of Washington have watched with keen interest for the first indication of the manner in which Mrs. Taft would conduct the social side of her duties as White House hostess. Those who have known her best in her official life in the Philippines and in Washington pretty clearly foretold just what would happen—the selection of a social clerk to execute her orders and the taking upon her own shoulders the full responsibility of the social side of Mr. Taft's administration as president.



After careful consideration Mrs. Taft selected Miss Alice Blech, until a few days ago a clerk in the bureau of American republics. She was so self-possessed, so modest, so business-like and so altogether capable that when brought to Mrs. Taft's attention she was promptly chosen. In outlining her work in a general way Mrs. Taft came to believe that a woman who would have to devote more than two-thirds of her time to assisting the nation's hostess in meeting guests pouring tea, shopping, walking, driving, etc., as well as generally acting as chaperon for the younger members of the family, would have but little time to devote to the clerical work of the position. Besides, Mrs. Taft had said that she never had had a social secretary and never wanted one.

From all this it must not be inferred that Miss Blech will have no responsibility upon her shoulders. She will not take the initiative in anything, but she will have a man's work to do, and will perform the tasks which were usually divided among two or three men.

Miss Blech must have at her fingertips all of the necessary references in the way of social registers, diplomatic lists, congressional directories, etc. She must study the subject of precedence in its most serious phases, and she must sort the living from the dead.

There are thousands of letters sent to a president's wife every month, including congratulations, appeals for help, letters from business men and women soliciting trade, and letters from societies and organizations, and especially from church societies asking for some thing, like a handkerchief, an autographed picture or similar trifle, to be raffled. Answers to these will be dictated to or written by the secretary. Mrs. Taft has a large personal correspondence, including members of her family and intimate friends to all of whom she will write personally, as she has always done.

Senator Presides at Town Meeting. Senator Henry Cabot Lodge of Massachusetts found time from his duties at Washington to run up to Nahant last week and preside as moderator at the annual town meeting. "It is to be hoped," says the Springfield Republican, "that he will keep up the custom as long as he lives, even if he has to make special trips from Washington. The influence of his example cannot fail to be most excellent, since the spectacle of so distinguished a statesman, whose range is national and world-wide, displaying a local patriotism of this sort must help to maintain the essential dignity of our local institutions."

Immune from Arrest. In Washington, in the capital of the nation, there reside 200 men who, with their households, have absolute immunity from the laws of the land, even though they commit crimes of the first degree. They may shoot down the man who injures them; they may, if they see fit, paint the new equestrian statue of Gen. Phil Sheridan a vivid pea green, yet the hands of Uncle Sam must be kept from their shoulders, and woe unto the untrifled policeman or other servant of the law who undertakes to bring them to justice once they have declared their official connections. These men who are so clothed in immunity, are the members of the diplomatic corps, and their shield is international law. It is provided in the laws of nations that they must answer before the tribunals of their own countries for the offenses they commit here in Washington, but that they shall not be tried by any court of the United States.
