THE RULES.

Governing Running or Trotting Races

Five to enter, Three to Start, Ten per cent of purse to enter. Running horses to carry weights according to the Western Jockey Club Rules.

Governing Relay Race

Each rider must have four horses, Change saddles at each 1-2 mile, To have helper to lead horses on track but no helper to saddle.

Entrance to all races close at 7 o'clock p. m. on the day previous to race All moneys divided 60-30-10.
