A matter that is of vital interest to all property owners and one which should receive the hearty support of them all is the work of completing the fire hall, at least the the interior of the lower room where the fire fighting apparatus is kept. The directors of the fire department have been unable so far to dispose of the bonds, offered for sale some time ago and as cold weather has already been experienced in this vicinity something ought to be done at once to raise enough funds to make the needed improvements and put the building in shape for winter. Through efforts on the part of Mr. Carey,

the janitor of the hall, a stove has been installed in which a fire is kept both day and night, but in extreme cold weather, this would not be sufficient to keep the apparatus in condition for immediate use. Steel sheeting has been ordered of the interior walls and lumber for the floor and the business men ought to aid the department in securing funds to meet the bills. Owing to the fact that the bonds could be disposed of at 5 per cent interest the Directors of the department are offering them now at 6 per cent, the highest rate allowed by law.
