ing were opened. Bids being those of L. A. Conser and O. A. Dahl. Moved by Wood and seconded by Fitzsimmons that contract for county printing be awarded to O. A. Dahl for a period of two years, in accordance with bid filed in the county clerk's office. All commissioners voting aye. Motion carried.

Moved by Wood and seconded by Baldwin that resignation of Dr. W. H. Young as coroner of Fallon County be accepted. Motion carried.

Moved by Baldwin and seconded by Wood that Dr. Baker be appointed coroner, to fill vacancy caused by resignation of Dr. Young. Motion prevailed, all commissioners voting in the affirmative. The Clerk was instructed to give written notice of the appointment of Dr. Baker as coroner.

Moved by Wood and seconded by Baldwin that the matter of the appointment of health officer be laid over until the January session. The candidates to proceed by petition. Motion carried.

Motion made by Baldwin and seconded by Fitzsimmons that bids for transcribing records be resealed awaiting opinion of county attorney as to disposition. Motion prevailed.

Moved by Fitzsimmons and seconded by Baldwin that A. Premo of Westmore be appointed Justice of the Peace, and C. A. Busch of Westmore as constable. Motion prevailed unanimously. Clerk to notify in writing Messrs. Premo and Busch of their appointment.

Moved by Baldwin and seconded by Wood that the county attorney be authorized to employ a stenographer at a salary not to exceed \$100.00 per month, to assist said attorney in office work. Motion carried, all commissioners voting aye.

Recess moved until 6:30 p. m. Board reconvened at 7:00 p. m. Proposition of the purchase of safes considered. By a vote the matter was laid on the table.

Recess moved until 9:30 a. m. Dec. 17.

DECEMBER 17.  
Panel of Commissioners met at 9:30 a. m.

Moved by Baldwin and seconded by Wood that the county purchase a safe of the Harring-Hall-Marvin Safe Co., dimensions inside 66x59 3/4x24 1/2 in., weight 6,500 pounds, at \$398.00, with a guaranteed freight rate not to exceed \$1.50 a hundred to Baker, Montana. Motion prevailed, all commissioners voting aye, by an aye and nay vote.

Moved by Wood and seconded by Baldwin that safes of the Dehold Safe & Lock Co. be purchased as follows: No. 620x, inside measurement 56x42 1/4 in., with inside money chest 18x18x16 1/2 in., weighing 5,000 pounds, costing \$420. A one dollar (\$1.00) freight rate to

Baker guaranteed, and if less than a one dollar (\$1.00) rate, county is to receive rebate. All commissioners voting aye, by an aye and nay vote.

Moved by Baldwin and seconded by Wood that one typewriter and small office supplies be purchased by Clerk and Recorder, typewriter for use of clerk's deputy, and small supplies for all county offices. Motion prevailed, all commissioners voting aye, by an aye and nay vote. Recess moved until 1:36 p. m. (Continued next week)
