No. 27 — Ordinance Amending and Repealing Certain Parts of Ordinance No. 4 and 23 Relating to Licenses.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Harlowton, that Article 8, Section 2, be made to read: Each Bus, Hack, Cab and Automobile to pay the sum of two dollars and fifty cents per quarter.


