Washington, 23.—Upon receipt of a copy of Major Fletcher's dispatch of the 20th instant, relative to Berry's arrest, the acting secretary of the Interior telegraphed to the Governor of Colorado as follows: This department is to-day advised, through the war department, that Berry has been arrested by the United States marshal and left the agency in charge of the officers of the station.

He held that where the owner of a distillery attempts to defraud the government the distilled spirits in the bonded warehouses are forfeited, without regard to the claim of wholesale liquor dealers who may have purchased them from the distiller, and notified the internal revenue collector of the purchase.
