TELEGRAPHIC BUCKEYE DEMOCRATS.

Columbus, 21.—The democratic state convention convened at 10 a. m. with the largest crowd ever seen on a similar occasion in Columbus. The contest between Ward and Hoadley for governor waged fiercely during the morning hours.

The second ballot proceeded till Butler County was reached again, and the same trouble was repeated. After the same had concluded some changes began for Hoadley and the greatest excitement prevailed, delegates climbing over each other and storming the platform.

The convention proceeded to nominate a Lieutenant governor and John G. Warwick, of Stark County, was selected by acclamation. Before the ballot was concluded Dewitt Coolman, of Portage County, and other candidates were withdrawn.

Columbus, Ohio, 21.—The work of nomination was frequently interrupted and delayed, and in the meantime Gen. Ward was made a speech in which he severely rebuked the party for failing to recognize his thirty years' service. He is thought not to be daunted and announced himself publicly as a candidate for the United States Senate.
