Mr. Lloyd told me of a touching tragedy which occurred some twenty years ago in these tombs. A party got to joking as to the amount of courage it would require to visit the tombs at the dead of night, alone, without a light.

Undoubtedly these subterranean cavities were once the tombs of great men; but scholars differ as to the antiquity they represent. Some throw them back to the time of David, while others maintain that they are not more ancient than the hieroglyphic age.
