WASHINGTON, December 16—Hatch, of Missouri, submitted a concurrent resolution that when the two houses adjourn on December 19th, they stand adjourned until January 5th.

Reed, commenting on the motion, said in this action the House rendered the matter a subject for legitimate comment before the House and country.

After some further debate, the resolution was amended so as to make the adjournment until December 22.
