TO TELEPHONE SUBSCRIBERS. Dear Sir: The Rocky Mountain Bell Telephone Company begs to advise you that, for reasons which appear below, it is compelled to announce an increase of rates, to take effect on and after May 1 next.

The new rates will be \$80 per annum for offices and \$60 for residences, with the usual additional charges on all instruments located over three-fourths of a mile from central office, these being the minimum rates now in force in Denver, Leadville, Kansas City and other similar cities.


