The Election. Yesterday dawned bright and clear and by the time the sun made its appearance over the eastern Wasatch the people began flocking to the voting places to cast their ballots and work for their respective parties.

No election was ever held perhaps in Ogden where harmony prevailed at the polls so much as it did here yesterday. It was generally believed that each of the polling places would be red hot from the very beginning, but such was not the case. Two brass bands were on the streets during the day, and aside from that nothing was visible to stir up enthusiasm for any ticket.

In the First ward the voting was done at the city hall. In the afternoon the election was one of the Liberal stronghold, and it was here the Democrats did some effective work. The Republicans tried to muster up enthusiasm, but somehow they did not do so well as they really expected. Bob Lundy engineered the Liberal electioneering.

In the Second ward the polls were located at Nelson & Peils' livery stable. The Second has always been the strongest Liberal precinct in the city, and the greatest strength seemed to be noticed there during the day.

The Third warders voted at the Mound Fort school house, where a good vote was polled. The Cortez building was the location of the Fourth ward polling place. The fight during the day in this ward seemed to be between the Democrats and Republicans. Hard work was done on all sides and at times quite a crowd was noticeable around the polls. The first thirteen votes cast were Democratic straight.

In the Fifth ward the Liberals did not seem to be in it from the start, and had it not been for Theodore Schausenbach they would not have perhaps secured as many votes as they did. The Democrats did good work in this ward.

Up to about 5 o'clock 1,500 out of 2,700 registered voters of the city had been cast. The only disturbance noted during the day was at the Fourth precinct where two well dressed fellows were arrested for threatening to commit bodily harm on the person of A. W. Wertz.

A Small Blaze.

The fire department responded to a alarm sent out from box No. 15 at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon. The blaze was located in a barn on Adams avenue, between Twenty-first and Second streets, belonging to Forrest & Shipley. The fire was started by a child playing with matches. By the prompt application of a garden hose, it was extinguished before the department arrived.

The County Clerk's Office.

County Clerk Ledwith issued a marriage license yesterday to Thomas Richards, aged twenty-four, of Rock Springs, and Miss Matilda Bacon, aged seventeen, of Ogden. No business was transacted in probate. The county officials were too deeply in the election.

It was quite amusing to see Fred J. Niesel, the Liberal candidate, around with an arm full of hand-bills which read: "OUR LIBERAL CANDIDATES. We are opposed to the disfranchisement of any loyal American citizen."


