

OUT A DUCKING. A Thousand Men Slaughter the Broad-Billed Bird.

The Duck Crop of the Last Three Days Estimated at 20,000—Great Sport.

Monday was the greatest duck day ever known in Utah, and more birds were slaughtered than on any previous day in the history of Utah. The banks of the rivers and fresh water lakes were as the skirmish lines on the eve of a great battle. At the mouth of the Jordan the gunners were so thick that there was a continuous bang! bang! bang! from daylight until dusk.

Convoys were seen to rise from the river with as many as fifty in the string but before they had passed the hunters that lined both sides of the stream there was not a single duck left. This destruction was kept up during the entire day, and the shooting was so promiscuous that many of the men were spotted with the shot in their faces, while others felt them sting through their clothes.

It was so common to hear the lead beads singing through the air that the men didn't pay any attention to it. Indeed, they were so excited and busy in peeping at the birds that nothing less than a cannon ball would have stirred them in any sense of danger. As far as can be learned there were no serious accidents.

Among the men who were led in the sack was Jack May, but he succeeded in capturing fourteen birds. O. C. Heester and C. D. Sheeler made up a team that cleared the air of fifty-one of the green-winged bustards. Heester bagging thirty-one and Sheester twenty.

Elmer Beck and Baby picked up eighty-one, a pretty neat pack of meat for one day's hunt. But this was thin shooting compared with the stories that came from Colorado at the mouth of the Bear, and what is singular—they bring the ducks along with their stories. There was one exception to this, as far as is noted, and that was the report of Captain Von Krolow who credited himself, Walt Dinoway and Henry Miles with 941 birds. Krolow once belonged to the English army and may be excused from being made president of the American club, as it comes natural to him. Krolow's statement when asked down is not more than 641 out of the way as the three brought their ducks to the river.

It was quite common to see a hunter return with that many and among the men who exceeded it was W. M. Anderson of Ogden, who secured 641. M. Anderson of this city, was made a present of 100 of these and vouchers for the correctness of his brother's returns.

But the real duck waters are Utah lake and the birds that are found on the Jordan and Bear rivers are only a few that wandered off in search of a change of scenery. Art and Harry Karetzky carry the duck pond as far as the Jordan. The Jordan is a beautiful water, a little inlet of Utah lake about ten miles from Provo in which there was a heavy growth of water lilies which concealed their beds and permitted them to move along clearing everything before them. Before night came on their boat was so full of meat that they had no room to stand in and they counted their gain at 400.

Charley Stanton and Will Lynch also made the air ring with their constant bang and through some ducks to keep the city quiet and in most for a month to come. Lynch, at one time, became so excited that he stepped out of his boat, forgetting about it being in water. This ducking did not dampen his power nor his enthusiasm. He is now a hundred hunters kept the birds on the wing at Williams lake, located about six miles west of Ogden. Councilman Beahm and Policeman Stanton bagged thirty-five each and Johnson, the real estate broker, brought home twenty-two.

It is estimated that during the last three days a thousand persons have been out gunning, and that they averaged twenty birds apiece, making the slaughter for that time 20,000 birds. Old sports report that they never knew the birds to be so plenty nor so easily reached, and they attribute it to the better enforcement of the game law.

The duck fever is contagious and there will be many more ducks in the market from a mud turtle, and to these it is very essential to know what kind of bird the teal duck is. If the society editor described the teal duck she would say: The head and neck of the green-winged teal are chestnut, the chin black and the forehead dusky; around the eyes and side of the head is a broad, rich copper stripe, passing into a dusky black patch on the nose; below white with rounded black spots on the throat; lower neck, sides and scapulars finely branched with black and grayish white speckles on wings broad and rich green; white crescent in front of head of wings; under tail covers black with a patch of full white on each side; wing coverts plain olive gray. In the female the under parts are white and the upper dark brown with gray edgings.
