

Baths—How to Take Them. Towel or Sponge Bath—Rubbing the whole surface of the body rapidly with a coarse, wet towel or sponge.

Sun and Air Bath—The sun and air bath can be enjoyed only on a clear and bright day, when, with the body entirely nude, lying on a mattress or lounge, the direct unobstructed rays of the sun are allowed to fall on the body.

Hip or Sitz Bath—A small-sized wash tub will do for this, although tubs constructed with a straight back, and raised four or five inches from the floor are much the more agreeable.

Wet Sheet Packing—On a bed or mattress two or three comfortable bedquills are spread, over them a pair of flannel blankets and a wet sheet—rather coarse linen is the best—sprung out lightly. The patient, undressed, lies down flat on the back, and is quickly enveloped in the sheet, blanket and other bedding.

General Bathing Rules—Never bathe soon after eating, but only when the stomach is empty, or nearly so.

No bath should be taken when a feeling of fatigue is present. Between 11 and 12 o'clock in the forenoon is the best time for bathing.

After a bath is taken, and the skin thoroughly dried, the surface of the body should be briskly rubbed for five minutes with dry hands. And remember that without proper and careful attention to diet, exercise, rest and pure air, bathing in itself will not amount to much as a health restorative.

Infections—These are warm or tepid, cool or cold. The former are used to relieve pain and produce free discharges; the latter to check excessive evacuations and strengthen the bowels.

For the former purpose a large quantity should be used; and for the latter purpose only a small quantity.—Katharine G. Townsend, M. D., in The Household.

Hansen Introduces a Resolution in the Board of Education.

DR. MILLSPAUGH FAVORS IT

COMMITTEE ON TEACHERS WILL INVESTIGATE AND REPORT.

Treasurer Whitney Files His Statement of Finances for March—Monies Received From County Collector and the Territorial Auditor—Other Business of the Board.

Mr. Hansen made a movement in the direction of reform in penmanship teaching at the meeting of the board of education last night by introducing the following resolution:

Resolved, That the board of education of this city, in view of the progress and high standing of the schools under its supervision and control, and in anxious desire to promote the welfare of every branch of the greatest possible degree, and through tests in many parts of the country have demonstrated the plainness, business utility, hygienic advantages, and general superiority of the vertical system of handwriting over the old slant style, and

Whereas, It is claimed the former is easier to learn, less difficult to teach and more durable than the student when acquired, that the latter, therefore, be discontinued, and the vertical system be adopted as the standard of penmanship in all the schools of this city.

Resolved, That the committee on teachers' salaries be requested to make a prompt investigation of its merits and authority, and report to the board as practicable their recommendations concerning it.
