It is a silver-lead-gold proposition and a three foot vein of workmen is now hard at work developing the ore bodies, which are said to be very extensive. The mine is located near the famous Buckhorn and the average value of the ore is \$35. It has been decided to ship to Leamington. The cost of transportation to market will be \$11.75, so that the lossers of the mine should make a neat little sum monthly.

ANOTHER DECREASE RECORDED.

Falling Off in Ore and Bullion Receipts Last Week.
What with the presence of a holiday, the partial closing down of the Pennsylvania smelters on account of an accident to the blower, the practical cessation of shipments from the Park and a great decrease from Bingham on account of the terrible condition of the roads, it is small wonder that the reported ore and bullion receipts for the past week fell well down toward the \$100,000 mark. The total receipts for the week were \$116,294, which was a decrease as compared with the total of the previous week of something over \$30,000. Even the receipt of several gold shipments did not make up for the other losses. Of gold, there was a total value of \$15,700, including a \$12,200 movement of Mercurian gold. Yesterday the Mammoth moved twelve carloads of concentrates the consignment being to the Guggenheims at Denver. The Centennial-Bureau also made several shipments to the same outfit. Down at the Ibbex everything is operating with comparative smoothness, and regular shipments of bullion and matte are being made.
