A VERDICT OF NOT GUILTY

JAMES TRUE DID NOT ROB THE TRAIN.

Jury stood ten to two for acquittal at the start—True discharged from custody.

The arguments in the True case were completed yesterday afternoon and the case went to the jury. Mr. Hamilton scored Cullen and McFarland, two of the principal witnesses for the plaintiff, and brought out the strong points in the incriminating testimony.

The jury heard the testimony of Cullen, saying it did not matter so far as the case went whether it was true or not. He laid great stress on proof which the prosecution had submitted adverse to the alibi theory and claimed that the alibi was disproved.

In his charge Judge Marshall advised the jury to disregard the evidence of Cullen. The jury retired about 7 o'clock.

At 10 o'clock the jury signified that they had agreed on a verdict. Judge Marshall and the court officials arrived half an hour later, and the jury handed in a verdict of not guilty. The verdict was unexpected, and most of those interested were predicting that the jury would be out all night. Mrs. True received in the court room until about 10 o'clock.

Attorney Armstrong was the only one of the counsel in the case present. He promptly made a motion for True's discharge, which was granted. True was pale as death when the jury came in. When they left the box he shook hands with all of the spectators and went over again: "You have made no mistake. I am an innocent man. It is said the jury stood ten for acquittal on the first ballot."

GERMANY'S ITEMIZED BILL.

New York, March 31.—Joseph Hartzel, an American Methodist bishop in Africa, who has just arrived from the dark continent, says that while he was in Liberia, a German gunboat arrived and demanded \$10,000 indemnity for an alleged injury to a German subject. The indemnity was calculated as follows: For damage to property, \$5,000; for threatening to stab the consul, \$2,500; for the expense of collecting the money with a gunboat, \$2,500.

President Colman refused to pay, whereupon the commander of the gunboat told him that Germany would waive the claim for the indemnity if a treaty was entered into placing Liberia under German protection. This was also declined and President Colman requested Bishop Hartzel to endeavor to move England and the United States to take action in his effort to remain independent of German and French interference.

The bishop says he has laid the matter before the British government and now is waiting for a reply to the government at Washington.

CHEER FOR CUBANS.

Glowing Telegram From Congressman Beach to the Junta. Washington, March 31.—Representative C. B. Beach of Ohio sent the following telegram to President Palma of Cuba: "Having maintained the war for three years by their own bravery, resources and sacrifices, until unprecedented heroism, will you accept compromise when they can overbear in the throat of their brutal enemy a death rattle? God forbid! Will you allow the Cuban people to be trampled under the feet of a foreign slave? Will it unrape your daughter? Will it revive the mother who urged them on with the last breath which starvation allowed? Fight! Fight! Uncle Sam is dining off his uniform."

ZOLA CASE AGAIN.

An Appeal That Promises an Adverse Result. Paris, March 31.—The court of cassation today began hearing the appeal of M. Zola against the sentence of one year's imprisonment and 1,000 francs fine imposed upon him Feb. 21. If the court, as is probable, accepts M. Chamberlain's report, the case will be re-tried. The condemnation will remain in effect until the case is re-tried. This result is believed to be a complete victory for the government, as it is expected it will stop the agitation of the Dreyfus sentence.

Spanish Fours.

London, March 31.—On the stock exchange this morning, Spanish 4's opened lower at 92 1/2 and further declined to 92. The closing quotations yesterday were 92 1/2.

In the federal court yesterday afternoon the trial of Robert Ross was begun. The charge against Ross was that of counterfeiting. It being alleged that he passed a bogus \$5 piece on John S. Baker, Oct. 7, 1887, at Junction, Platte county, Ross defends in that he did not know the coin was spurious.
