Washington, May 31.—The house today adopted a concurrent resolution directing the commission now studying the riming laws to prepare and submit a code of civil law and procedure for Alaska.

A number of private bills were passed, and the house, in committee of the whole, considered a bill authorizing the secretary of the treasury to keep open during June and July, this year, such life-saving stations on the Atlantic and gulf coasts as he might deem advisable.

The bill was urged by the secretary of the navy, as providing for the continuance of the monthly named of an important adjunct to the naval and coast signal service in making efficient the patrol service.

After some lengthy discussion, the bill was amended to carry \$70,000, instead of \$25,000, and passed.
