

POLICE BOARD PRESIDENT WILKINSON Special Precautions by Salt Lake Police. CHIEF HILTON'S PLANS DETECTIVES TO MEET PARTY AT STATE LINE.

The safety of the nation's chief executive when he visits this state, probably in April, will be most carefully looked after by a detail of Salt Lake policemen and detectives, who will act as a special body guard to the president to protect him from all possible sources of danger from the time he crosses the northern line of Utah until he passes over the eastern boundary.

The chief said that he had no power himself to send his men out of the city, but that if the plan met the approval of the government, a detail of detectives would be dispatched to meet the president at the state line and conduct him safely to this city. Their duties will be to watch for any dangerous characters and boost them out of the state or land them in the city jail.
