BIG MINING SUIT AT NEPHI

Manager Morris Dusseldorf of the Comstock at Park City received yesterday samples from the north upraise.

The atreak which has been followed up from the 300-foot level for 100 feet has widened out until it has become a two-and-a-half-foot body of solid shipping ore.

Superintendent Hickey was assayed and the returns received late yesterday afternoon were as follows: Lead, 65.1 per cent; silver, 35.5 ounces; gold, \$2.40.

Effect of Big Shipment of Gold to Europe.

HESITATING TONE IN STOCKS

WAS ACUTE DEPRESSION IN SOME SECURITIES.

New York, Nov. 18.—The largest shipment of gold which ever left New York in a single day will be carried on the steamship sailing tomorrow and touching at French and German ports.

The day's greatest depression came before the total engagements of gold had been set in and continued on the face of the latter incident to the movement.

Outside of this special portion of the gold the vigorous expressions of opposition to the company and its objects by the governor of Minnesota, who entrenched behind laws on the state statute books.

Assurances, however, were given out in Washington that the federal government had been fully considered, and that in the opinion of learned counsel here there was no legal ground for the northern Securities company.

Notwithstanding the uncertainty of the exact amount of gold to be shipped, opinion over the money outlook continues optimistic, based on the offsets which developed last week to the outflow of gold.

Provisions opened somewhat strong, advancing in the face of the grain weakness. January pork closed higher at 15.10; January lard at 8.90 and January ribs 7 1/2c higher at 7.75.
