WATER SUPPLY SHORT AGAIN

Street Sprinklers Off and Dust is Flying.

CANYON CREEKS ARE LOW

RAIN IS NEEDED TO RELIEVE THE SITUATION.

UNLESS a rainstorm comes within the next few days, the supply of water will be so short that the people of this city will certainly believe they are up against another famine situation. The canyon creeks have shrunk to the lowest stage ever known, and the fear is that the flow will bring less each day until rain brings relief. The weather man can see no storm coming.

SHRINKAGE OF CREEKS.

Illustrative of the prevailing conditions, Superintendent Hines cites that a year ago Parley's canyon creek flowed at the daily rate of 5,312,000 gallons, while yesterday the flow had shrunk to 3,770,000 gallons. City creek flowed yesterday at 4,710,000 gallons, whereas a year ago it was 6,714,000 gallons, making a total loss of supply of about 2,900,000 gallons each twenty-four hours.
