Ransch Outrides Other Jockeys and Lands Winner.

TWO FUTURITY ENTRIES START IN YESTERDAY'S RACES.

San Francisco, Dec. 18.—The feature of the racing at Ingleside today was the event for 2-year-olds at five furlongs. It was marked by the appearance of Sylvia Talbot and The Fog, two of the candidates for the \$16,000 Futurity to be run Saturday.

HELENA GIVES SUPPORT

Senators' President Says His Club Will Stick by Pacific Northwest League.

American Will Hold Meeting.

Chicago, Dec. 18.—President Johnson of the American League today announced that the annual meeting of his league would be held in this city, probably next Monday, and that the first contest between the peace committees of the rival leagues would be held in Cincinnati on Jan. 8.

Concerning the outlook for peace Mr. Johnson said he believed a satisfactory compromise could be reached, but he declined to talk in advance of the probable terms.

There will be two leagues and not a consolidation into a twelve-club circuit.

Big Leagues May Consolidate.

Cleveland, Dec. 18.—Relative to the statement made by Harry Pulliam, the new president of the National League of Baseball Clubs, that a possible result of the meeting in New York next month might be a consolidation of the American and the National leagues, Vice President Somers of the American League today said that no matter how much such a step would be desired by certain club owners, the American league would not enter into any such agreement.
