

TO MAKE CITY A PACKING CENTER

Steps Are Taken by Real Estate Association. LEARY PRESENTS SITUATION

Definite steps were taken yesterday by the Salt Lake Real Estate Association for erecting a packing house and establishing a livestock market in Salt Lake City.

At the close of the meeting a resolution was unanimously passed appointing a committee to take definite action and formulate plans for the erection of a packing house and the establishment of a local livestock market.

Mr. Leary said: Mr. Chairman and Gentlemen of the Association. It can be seen from statistics that every city in the United States which has sufficiently encouraged the location of packing houses and the upbuilding of a local market for livestock to induce their establishment has tremendously increased its commerce and expanded the productive possibilities of its territory.

Records of Many Cities. Indianapolis and its productive territory helped build up Cincinnati in its early packing days. It is a fact that that city's facilities of its own would contribute to the Hoosier capital's like advancement.

Twenty years ago Denver was an enjoyable living place because of its proximity to the mountains and its productive fields. It was not an inviting location for the establishment of a packing house.

Big Business Now Done. During the first year of their operations the Leary yards have received receipts valued at \$2,000,000; two years later the value had increased to \$3,000,000; and last year the value of business reached \$7,000,000.

Chance For Utah. To this increase of business Utah has contributed largely. For several years it is generally admitted we have been among the best of Denver's customers.

Health on our eastern border enjoys no present day superiority over the land in which we live. Our once numerous and healthy population has been reduced and adapted themselves to changed physical conditions.

Utah Stock Grows Better. In the progress of this evolution it is encouraging to note in this connection the improvement of quality attained with the expansion of home feeding.

Large Business Already Done. There are approximately 10,000 cattle a year being killed in Salt Lake and distributed from this point.

Immediate Action Desirable. In the interest of the city and state, consumers and producers alike, as well as the general public, it is deemed desirable that the organized representatives of our trade should immediately exert their influence to supply the existing deficiency.
