CONFLICT OF INTERESTS. KANSAS CITY, Mo., June 9.—Professor Hugo R. Meyer of the University of Chicago, addressing the National Federation of Millers today on the question of governmental regulation of railroad rates, maintained that "whenever the public regulation of railway rates has sought to do more than to eliminate secret rebates, and to guarantee that rates shall be reasonable, per se, it has arrested the decline of railway rates and has led to the adoption of the distance tariff.

DIFFICULTY OF MAKING RATES RIGHT TO BE HEARD. Ancient Marshals Will Present Memorials to Czar.
