

UTAH GUARDS TO ENTER MATCH RUN, CHILDREN, FROM HIERARCH

Team from Militia Will Compete For Prizes on Sea Girt Rifle Range. Somebody Reports Strange Animal in Skull Valley.

PREPARE FOR ENCAMPMENT GREAT EXCITEMENT THERE

STRAWBERRY VALLEY IS FAVORED BY BOARD. HUNT IS BEING ORGANIZED WITH FIFES AND DRUMS.

COLONEL JOSEPH GEOGHEGAN, acting adjutant general, N. G. U., announces that the men have been selected to prepare for the trip to Sea Girt, N. J., where a competitive rifle shoot is to be held in September. This move began with the forwarding of a letter in the adjutant general's office which had been "pigeon-holed" by former Adjutant General J. M. Bowman some time in March. The letter from the war department states that Utah is entitled to a team to compete at the national rifle tournament this year, and also requested that a team of twelve principals, three supernumeraries, one coach, one team spotter, and one captain. These are all to be members of the organized militia. Each state is entitled to such a team, and the United States army and United States navy are also entitled to a team each. The Utah men will have some trouble in winning from these numbers on account of the short time left to prepare, thanks to one Bowman.

Many Cash Prizes. Prizes amounting to \$25,000 will be distributed among the winning teams in the way of cash prizes and medals. Several prominent men, including President Roosevelt, have offered prizes in the way of trophies to be awarded to the states sending the winning teams. The team will leave in the early part of September and will go by way of Chicago and New York. All expenses will be paid with money appropriated in addition to the prize money, by congress annually.

Another communication from the war department uncovered yesterday, it is found that the government has a school in Utah for the training of national guard officers in a military line. Utah is entitled to five students in this school, but has not been selected by the former officials and it is too late to send officers there this year. However this will be attended to in good time next year.

To Camp at Strawberry. Yesterday afternoon a board of officers was appointed to decide on the place for the annual encampment. The board consists of Colonel P. Kessler, Colonel A. B. Irvine, Colonel H. M. H. Lund, Captain W. C. Webb and Captain Freeman Bassett. With the exception of Colonel Kessler the board is in favor of Strawberry valley. Colonel Kessler favors Mant. Should the guard go to Strawberry, the board is in favor of the train to Heber and from there they will make a two days' march to the valley. The driving will be different from what they have had before. A camp there would also be minus fair visitors.
