

FORT DOUGLAS NOT LIST Report That \$1,000,000 Was Appropriated for Improvements Declared False.

UTAH DELEGATION FAILS REMOVAL OF CAPTAIN HAM IS EXPLAINED.

For some time an impression has prevailed in Salt Lake that an appropriation of \$1,000,000 was made for the improvement of Fort Douglas, and surprise has been expressed that this money was not put to the use for which it was supposed to have been intended.

According to these letters, the general improvements that have been in progress for the last three or four years at the post have been under the immediate direction of the quartermaster general, and were not included in the plans of the general staff.

In his letter Senator Sutherland states that "the regular appropriations heretofore made for the establishment of new posts and the improvement of those now in existence have been distributed in their entirety by the general staff, and Fort Douglas has not been included for any amount whatsoever."

Senator Sutherland also explains why the two batteries were recently ordered transferred from Fort Douglas to Fort D. A. Russell.

The letter of Congressman Howell contains practically the same information that Senator Sutherland has given.
