

SMALL CHANCE FOR HONEST MAN

Standard Oil Inquiry Brings Out Story of Wrong and Oppression.

HEARING AT CLEVELAND, O.

STRUGGLES OF AN INDEPENDENT COMPANY.

Cleveland, O., May 24.—Interstate Commerce Commissioners Prouty and Clemens resumed the investigation of the Standard Oil company with reference to freight rates by today.

F. B. Westgate, the first witness, and an independent oil man for nineteen years, testified that since 1888 rates had nearly doubled without apparent reason.

The further testimony of the witness was principally devoted to relating the trials and hardships of his company, the United States Pipe Line company, in building pipe lines across Pennsylvania from Oil City to the seaboard in competition with the Standard Oil company.

The morning session adjourned at noon with Senator Emery on the stand.

Senator Emery of Bradford, Pa., took the stand again when the afternoon session began. He related further history concerning his fight against the Standard, giving one instance of how a refinery at Philadelphia was compelled to go out of business because the railroads raised the rates to an exorbitant figure, and also scattered their tank cars to the distant corners of the country.

ANTIQUITIES TO BE PRESERVED

Senate Passes a Bill Endorsed by a Score or More Societies.

Washington, May 24.—A measure for the preservation of American antiquities which has the endorsement of a score or more societies in this country has been ordered reported favorably by the senate committee on public lands.

Under the bill ordered reported, any person who shall appropriate, excavate, injure or destroy any historic or prehistoric ruin or monument, or any object of antiquity situated on lands owned or controlled by the United States, upon conviction shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment for not more than ninety days or both.
