SODA FOUNTAIN IS OPENED

Handsome New One Installed at Keith-O'Brien's Does a Rushing Business.

The new soda fountain that has just been installed by the Keith-O'Brien company was opened yesterday. The candy department was also opened. The fountain is made from the best Italian and Georgia marble that can be quarried, and has bronze trimmings.

In the ice chest only marble and plate glass are used, and they are cooled by a cold storage process that is set up in the basement of the building. It is thirty feet long, and it is of the latest design which prevails throughout the east.

At the opening yesterday both departments were crowded, and in the evening there were many people in line trying to get a chance to sample the goods from the soda fountain.

Extending from the two ends of the fountain and the heads of the staircase were long lines of pink roses, which met in the center and suspended a large bouquet. On the four corners were pieces of lattice work covered with vines of pink roses.
