Neighbor of Talisman in Beaver County Taps Rich Ore off Shaft Workings.

STRIKE IN LITTLE CHIEF

NEW HOISTING WORKS FOR MAGNOLIA-ST. LOUIS.

In a short cross-cut from the 235-foot mark in the shaft being sunk on the Cedar Mining company's property, a fissure has just been tapped that shows from eight to ten inches of the richest kind of lead-silver carbonate ore.

The shaft is about fifteen feet below the 235-foot level now and the letter which accompanied the samples sent up by Superintendent Henry Green stated that another fissure had been cut in the shaft.

Higher up several seams of ore had been cut and, from the action of all of them, it is expected that the ore will merge and form a compact and large body of fine shipping ore.

The shaft on the Cedar property is being dug down at a short distance from the workings of P. B. McKean's famous Talisman and the management of that section at that time when moderate depth has been attained another fine producer will be added to Beaver county's richly producing list.

SHEBA MEETING HELD.
