GRAND RUSH TO SELL IS OVER

Upward Trend in Prices of Stocks in Wall Street Manifest at the Opening.

MONEY MARKET IS EASIER

CONDITIONS AGAIN APPEAR MOST FAVORABLE.

New York, Nov. 26.—There were none of the signs of selling out of collateral in loans in today's stock market such as has been the depressing influence at intervals for some time past.

The approach of the end of the month leaves open a probability of a temporary hardening of money rates to meet the large requirements of that period.

The interest and dividend payments for December still show an aggregate far in excess of previous years, arguing the continued high rate of distribution of profits.

The refusal to take commercial paper by the small interior banks is charged by the New York dealers to be an accompaniment of a piling up of cash holdings to the point of surfeit.

Washington, Nov. 26.—Today's statement of the treasury balances in the general fund, exclusive of the \$150,000,000 gold reserve, shows: Available cash balance, \$249,643,311; gold coin and bullion, \$16,631,291; gold certificates, \$80,968,470.


