"Benevolent" Support Withdrawn—Protective Measures No Longer Necessary.

WASHINGTON NEWS HURTS LOWER PRICE FOR COPPER AN INCIDENT.

New York, Jan. 29.—No effective obstacles were interposed to prevent the downward drift of prices of stocks today, which seemed on a much diminished volume of business from that which has been true for many days past.
