

GIRL'S DEATH IN DEEP MYSTERY

Suspicion Surrounds Taking of Fatal Dose of Poison by Ruby Dickman.

Three Doctors Refuse to Sign Certificate Man with whom she had been living has disappeared.

Ruby Dickman came to her death in a mysterious manner in room 19 at the Imperial hotel at 2:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon.

Death was due to morphine poisoning and it was probably a case of suicide, although the circumstances surrounding the case were such that none of the attending physicians would sign the certificate.

The girl, whose name the authorities are investigating, was living with Charles Barnett, a waiter. They were registered at the hotel as man and wife.

Woman Cannot Be Awakened. The couple went to the Imperial hotel on June 28, where they registered as "C. Barnett and wife."
